## 2017 "Christmas Carol Parade" Parade Guidelines

Thank you for participating in our annual Christmas parade and helping to make this a safe, FUN event! In an effort to make this process flow smoothly please remember the following guidelines:

- Every entry must be decorated in the "Christmas Carol on the Bricks" parade theme or holiday theme.
- Line-up will be on Wills Street
- Lineup will open at 10:30AM and will be on a "first come" basis with horses and walkers being managed by parade director.
- Entries should be complete prior to entering the line up unless prior arrangements are made.
- Vehicles not entered in the parade cannot enter line-up.
- If you are delivering a child to a float you may walk them to their destination. When possible a shuttle will take them to their float from the city lot. Please drop them off on Highland Rd only at entrance. There will not be space to pull a car in and turn around. DO NOT go to FM751 at the beginning of the parade line up and try to enter!
- If you have children on your float they **must** stay on the float during line-up and the parade.
- Trucks with horse trailers and tow trucks may park in city yard.
- Do not leave any animals unattended.
- ALL entries must be in line up by 11:45 am to be in parade. DO NOT ATTEMPT TO ENTER THE PARADE AT ANY OTH-ER LOCATION THAN THE OFFICIAL LINE UP as our announcer will be following a specific line-up order.
- If we don't have your information we can't announce your float! Be sure you provide us with proper information. If you have turned a form in prior to December 9 we will have your announcement form prepared when you arrive. Following December 7 please have your form ready when you arrive.
- All entries should have a banner or clear signage on the float that is visible to both sides of the street that identifies the float sponsor to spectators. Basic, simple signs with 6-8" lettering works best.
- Judging will take place IN THE PARADE LINE UP PRIOR TO THE BEGINNING OF THE PARADE! If you want to be
- included in the judging you MUST be in the line up before 12:15 PM!
- Award winners will be announced at approximately 12:45 (schedule permitting), prizes will be awarded and the Wills Point Chronicle will have a representative available to take pictures at that time. Award winners will have banners carried by Santa's "elves" in front of their entry during the parade.
- Individual passenger vehicles do not qualify as floats.
- Please do not have Santa on your float.
- Throwing candy from your float is allowed, but please be mindful to throw it far enough away from moving vehicles for safety purposes. Also, do not throw "at" people and risk hitting someone. Have adults monitor children throwing candy.
- During the parade be sure to close the gap between your entry and the one in front of you. On 4th Street there will be a parade director to help manage spacing for announcement purposes.
- No smoking or alcoholic beverages allowed.
